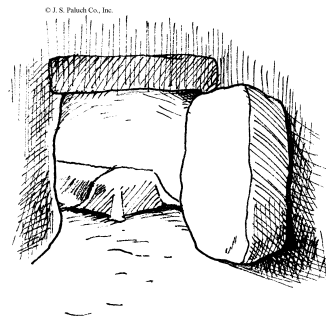
Book Club News!
