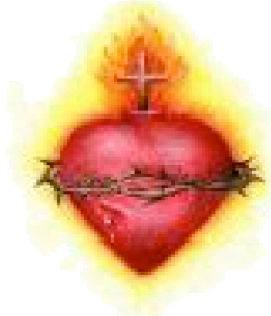

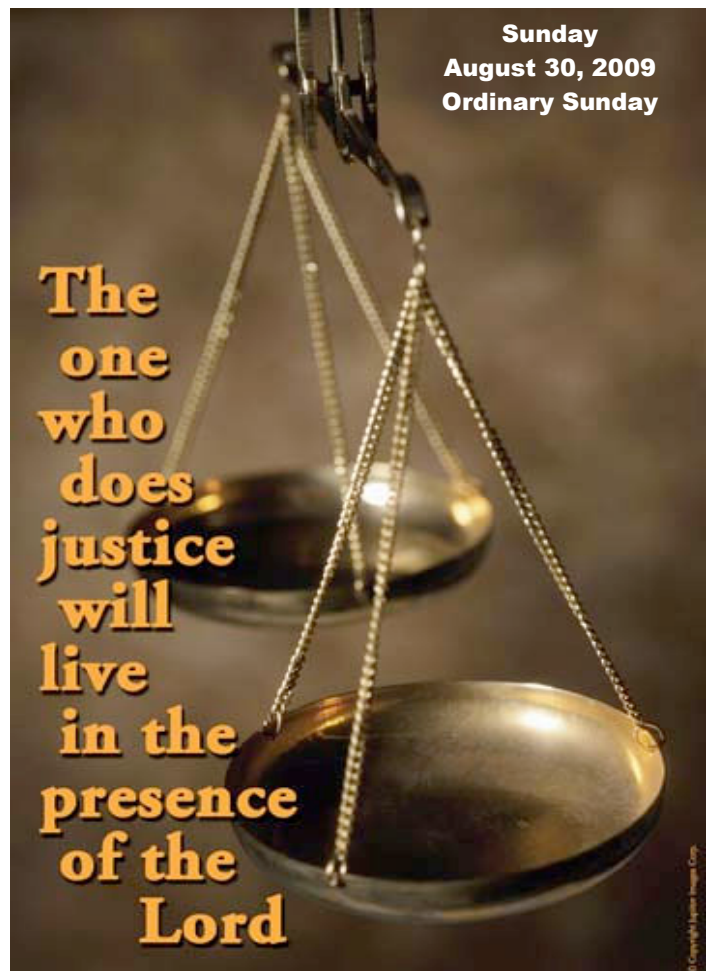

Seminar of The Holy Spirit in Creole from September 20th to November the 8th, 2009

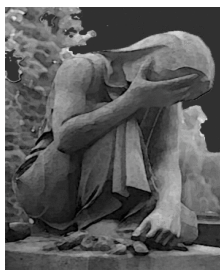
