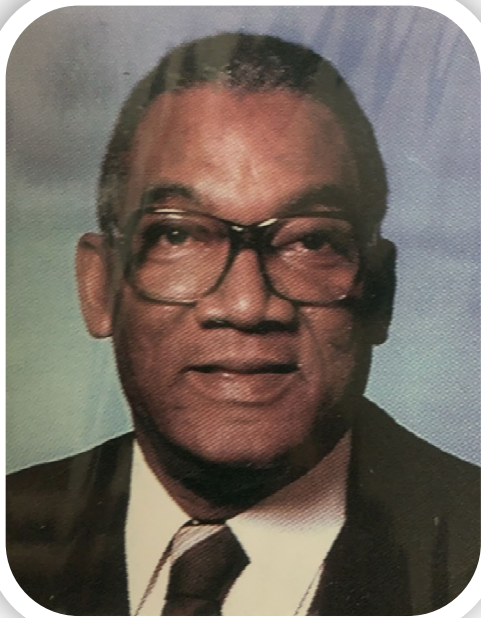

DEACON ROY ANTHONY DUDLEY

Born: June 20, 1931

Ordained: May 5, 1990

Died: June 6, 2018

DEACON ROY ANTHONY DUDLEY is the 17th child in line of 21 siblings, born on June 20, 1931, to Alberta and Edward Dudley. He studied in La Boca Elementary and High school. In 1950, the family moved to Camp Baird, Canal Zone, where he completed his schooling.

He was married to Relmina Dudley for 60 beautiful years. He worked for Panama Canal Zone Government for 15 years. He had four (4) children: Rogelio, Virgilio, Carlos and Guillermo. He had a total of 18 grandchildren.

He was a lector, leader of songs, member of the Holy Name and Legion of Mary at St Joseph Church, Panama.

He migrated to the United States with his sons on August 11, 1966 where the family was reunited with his lovely wife Relmina, who cleared the path for the family to be reunited. He attended St. John the Baptist Church in Brooklyn, where he was a leader of songs, lector, president of St Vincent De Paul Society, member of the Legion of Mary and the Holy Name Society.

Deacon Dudley and his family moved to Cambria Heights Queens, New York, in 1970, where he became a member of Sacred Heart Church. He was a leader of songs, Eucharistic Ministers, lector and taught confirmation class and CCD class at Sacred Heart Church.

He studied long and tedious hours, in order to receive his Air Condition, Refrigeration License. He was an operating engineer for Metropolitan Life Insurance Company in Manhattan, New York, for about 20 years, prior to his retirement.

Deacon Dudley joined the Diaconate Program and was ordained Deacon on May 5, 1990. One of the few things that troubled him, as witnessed by his wife and sons is that he suddenly became ill after completing the Diaconate program, and was not able to properly serve God, the church and his community, the way he would have liked.

During his earlier years, Deacon Dudley was a great musician, he played the saxophone and base guitar. He loved swimming, cooking and played baseball. He was also a great dancer and loved to dance and swim with his wife, Relmina. His favorite baseball team was the Cleveland Indians. For those of us who knew Deacon Dudley, FAILURE was not part of his vocabulary.

The name JOBE was given to him by his youngest brother, Franklin, because of the many hurdles, obstacles and suffering during his lengthy life. What was so special about Deacon Dudley, was that he never complained.

Deacon Roy Dudley will always be remembered as a devoted loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, uncle, cousin, godfather and friend, who will always be remembered for his many good deeds.

Deacon Dudley would have liked to let all of us know about two (2) of his adopted daughters Carol Jobson and Denise Carrington, who were there for his wife and family. Deacon Roy Dudley passed away on June 6, 2018, at 8:55pm. He departed from us, with his loving wife and family at his bedside.

Your Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish is eternally grateful to God and to the Dudley's family for the gift of **Deacon Dudley** to the Church. May he rest in the peace of Christ as we keep him and his family in our prayers!
