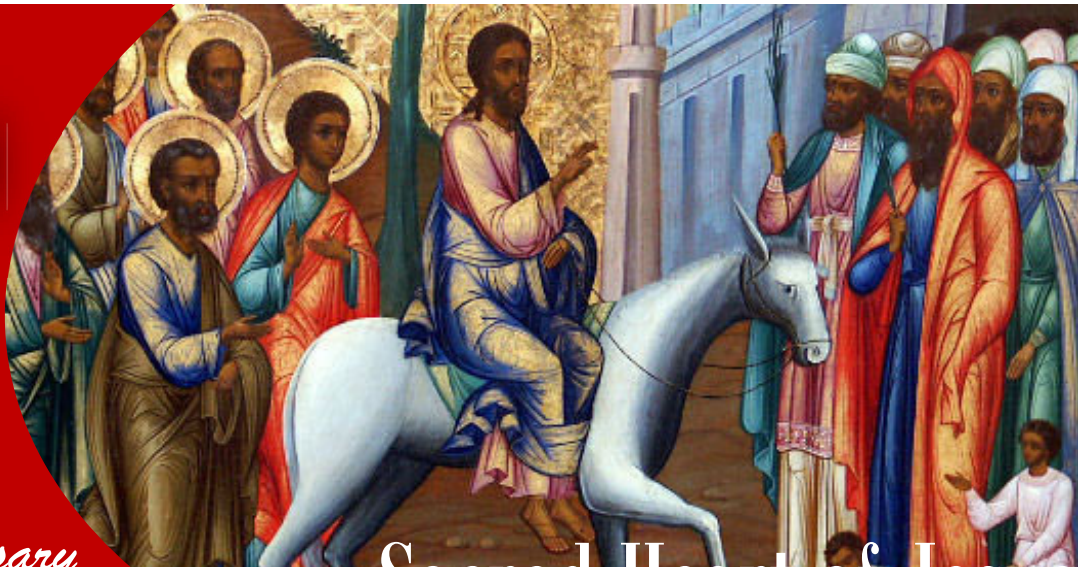

LENTEN REGULATIONS ON FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Abstinence – All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday & the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting - All the faithful between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.
